Justice of the next Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto James Buchanan of a plea of Trespass upon y<sup>e</sup> Case and that he have them and there the said writ Vc. . . Off which said next Court viz. the nineteenth day of November the same Year last mentioned the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent High Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed as

And whereupon the ap<sup>t</sup> ptt by Thomas Bourse his atty Complainis for that whereas the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft the fourth day of August in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventeen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County within y<sup>e</sup> Jurisdiction of this Court in Consideration that the ap<sup>t</sup> ptt at the special instance and request of the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft had then and there sold and delivered to the said Deft to the proper use and behoofe of the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft divers good and Merchandises in the amount hereto annexed specifically set forth at the several Rates & prices in the said Quo. mentioned amounting to the sume of one thousand and twelve pounds of Merchantable Tobacco upon himself assumed and to the said ptt then and there faithfully promised that he the said Deft the ap<sup>t</sup> one thousand and twelve pounds of Tobacco to the said ptt when thereunto required would well and truly pay and Content. And that whereas also the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft afterwards viz. the ap<sup>t</sup> fourth day of August in the Year of at the parish County and Jurisdiction ap<sup>t</sup> in Consideration that the ap<sup>t</sup> ptt at the like special instance and request of the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft had then and there last mentioned sold and delivered to the said Deft to the proper use and behoofe of the ap<sup>t</sup> Deft divers goods and Merchandises in an Quo. hereto annexed specifically set forth upon himself assumed and to the said ptt then and there last mentioned faithfully promised that he the said Deft so much Merchantable Tobacco as the ap<sup>t</sup> last mentioned Goods and Merchandises sold and delivered as ap<sup>t</sup> were at the time of the Sale & delivery thereof at reasonable rates and prices worth and amount to unto the said ptt when thereunto required would well and truly pay and Content and the ap<sup>t</sup> ptt. indeed saith that the ap<sup>t</sup> last mentioned Goods and Merchandises sold and delivered as ap<sup>t</sup> at the time of the Sale
