Whereas the said Dett having had his trial in the Custody of the Sheriff of said County for want of Special Bailie in the aff' dition And now at the prayer of the aff' ditor this Court here commits the said Dett in Execution into the Custody of the Sheriff of said County there to remain till he shall satisfy the Damages & Costs
