 sterling money which he unjustly detains &c. and that he have  
 them and there the said writ &c. . . At which said next Court viz.  
 the nineteenth day of November the 4<sup>th</sup> year the day of return of  
 said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. Sheriff of said County &  
 made return thereof in these words thereon Endorsed as follows viz.  
 Cap<sup>l</sup> Cap<sup>l</sup> of Wilmer's Tied. and the 4<sup>th</sup> pt by Thomas  
 Bowne his atty. Saith that the p<sup>ts</sup> are not inhabitants in  
 this County. Prays that he may be allowed as Security for the p<sup>ts</sup> to pay  
 Cost of the said Debt should appear to the ap<sup>l</sup> Auon and cast the  
 p<sup>ts</sup> in ap<sup>l</sup> Auon ap<sup>l</sup>. which was granted. in which Thomas Bowne  
 comes into Court and Saith that he will pay the Cost in ap<sup>l</sup> Auon  
 ap<sup>l</sup> to the said Debt if the p<sup>ts</sup> should be cast in the same and  
 pay it not himself.

and the said Debt being called came and the said p<sup>ts</sup> by —  
 Thomas Bowne his atty. prays that the said Debt may give  
 Special Baile to the ap<sup>l</sup> Auon which is granted and that he be  
 kept in safe Custody by the Sheriff of said County untill he shall  
 give Special Baile as ap<sup>l</sup>.

after which comes into Court Sam<sup>l</sup> Ledger God and Elizabeth  
 Resni both of said County and they and each of them acknow:  
 ledge themselves Special Baile in the ap<sup>l</sup> Auon and they and  
 either of them do undertake the payment of the debt ap<sup>l</sup> and  
 Cost thereon accruing if the ap<sup>l</sup> p<sup>ts</sup> should obtaine Judgment  
 against the said Debt. in the said Auon of Debt and the said —  
 Debt. the Condemnation should not satisfy nor himselfe to the  
 Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that they the said —  
 Sam<sup>l</sup> Ledger God and Elizabeth Resni or either of them the body  
 of the said Thomas Heakstone shall not render &c.

after which the said Debt in his proper person appeared to the  
 above Auon and prayd liberty thereof to impare thereto and to  
 answer at next Court which is granted the same day is given y<sup>e</sup>
