Moore of Kent County weaver if he should be found in his Body with and him safe keep so that he have his body before his Lordship's Justice of the next Court to be holden at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto William Frisby of a plea that he render to him of full Just Sum. of Nine pounds five Shill Current money of this Province which to him he owes & from him he unjustly detain &c. . . And that he have then and there the said writ &c. . . At which said next Court viz. the nineteenth day of November the same Year after the day of Return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words Myself Embraced as said by Non Est Invented by W. Wilmer the said and deed being filed when said writ shewd forth and a Copy thereof left at the last place of the Defts abode according to Act of Assembly in such Case made as said by.

County weaver was summoned to answer unto William Frisby of a plea that he render to him the full & just sum of nine pounds five Shill Current money of this Province which to him he owes & from him he unjustly detain &c. And whereupon the afores^d Atty by Thomas Browne his Attorney saith that whereas the afores^d Defend^t the fourteenth day of May in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventeen at St Pauls Parish in Kent County afores^d within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing obligatory which he the J^r Defend^t sealed with his seal and as his deed delivered hereinto Court brought the date whereof is the same day and year afores^d bound himself his Heir Exec^r & Admin^r to pay or cause to be paid to the said P^t by the name of William Frisby of Kent County Sheriff the afores^d full and just Summ of nine pounds five Shill Current money of this Province att or upon the tenth day of August next ensuing the date of the afores^d writing obligatory yett the afores^d Defend^t all the often required the afores^d nine pounds five Shill Current money to y^e J^r P^t hath not paid but that to him to render or pay or cause to be paid the J^r Defend^t hath denied and yett detle deny and Unjustly detain to the damage of the J^r P^t ten pounds Current money afores^d & thereupon he brings sile &c
