M<sup>r</sup> Elwin Anderson of this County bring<sup>s</sup> a negro Girl called Moll to be adjudged on view of the same. It is ordered by this Court here that the same Negro Girl is nine years old.

Lordship I Recog<sup>n</sup> taken of Col Natti Hynson one of his Lordships Justices at his said County for app<sup>t</sup> to this Court and now at this Court in Laughlin his proper person appears to the same ordered by the Court here that the same Recog<sup>n</sup> and his Sureties Recog<sup>n</sup> made for his app<sup>t</sup> be discharged. The afo Laughlin Hynson Recog<sup>n</sup> taken the seventeenth day of October last in y<sup>e</sup> time of Twenty pounds Sterling for the appearance of the said Laughlin to this Court &c and now at this Court no person showing any cause why the same Recog<sup>n</sup> ought not to be discharged this Court here now discharges the same.

likewise at the same time afo David Flinn and John Seats both of said County entered into Recog<sup>n</sup> in the sum of ten pounds Sterl each for the appearance of the afo Laughlin to this Court &c and now at this Court no person showing any cause why the same Recog<sup>n</sup> each of them ought not to be discharged this Court here discharges the same Recog<sup>n</sup> each of them.

His Lordship Maryland Kent County to the Jurors for the Hon<sup>t</sup> the Lord Proprietarie & the Body of Kent County on their Oath doff sent that Marg<sup>r</sup> Murrough of Laster Nock hundred the first day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Seventeen at Eastern Nock hundred in this County afo did Commit fornication with a certain man to the Jurors unknown to y<sup>e</sup> high displeasure of Almighty God and the well example of others and against the peace of our said Lord Proprietarie his rule and dignity & an Act of Assembly in such case made & provided

The Bell to John Evans foreman and the afo Margaret being called came and in her proper person appeared to the afo judgment ordered by this Court here that she proceed the person that did Commit fornication with her which she denyeth. But saith that she cannot gainsay the indictment afo and that she hath been guilty of Committing fornication afo and I<sup>t</sup> submit her selfe to the Conson the afo Judgment. Therefore it is considered by the Court here v<sup>i</sup> this twenty second day of November Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Seventeen that the afo Margaret Murrough be carried to the whipping post and there to receive on her bare back Twenty one Cashes well laydon her bare back till the blood appear and pay the sume of two hundred and one pounds of Tobacco Cast aurewing on the premises afo to the officers of this Court.

It is considered by the Court here v<sup>i</sup> the same day last mentioned that the Sheriff of said County take the afo Margaret Murrough into his Custody and to execute the stripes in the judgment afo and then to bring her into Court againe after which the same day last mentioned came the Sheriff of said County with the body of the said Margaret Murrough and made return of his precept against the said Margaret Murrough endorsed as folle v<sup>i</sup> in the morning record and Executed by Willmer Tho<sup>r</sup>.

Ordered by the Court here that the afo Margaret Murrough serve her Master Col Thomas Burgher six months at the expiation of her time for trouble about the afo Margaret in time of Travell loose time charge in delivering her of her Child and disgrace of his house.
