 ordered by the Court here that her Master at the expiration of her time of service
 deliver the said Margaret Murrrough to the Court or their so that she may
 make satisfaction for the charges the County pay for her

Kent Countys The Jurors for the Hon. the Lord
 Proprietarie and the body of Kent County of upon
 their Oath do present that Mary Savender of St
 Pauls parish in Kent County of Spinites servant to
 William Glenwill the first day of August in the year
 of Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and
 seventeen and at divers other times in the ap^{ts} year at the parish ap^{ts} in the County
 and within the Jurisdiction of this Court the fear of God before her eyes not having
 did Commit fornication with a certain Negro man his name to the Jurors un-
 known and there did suffer her selfe to be begott with a Molatto Child ag-
 the peace of the said Proprietaries his rule and dignity and the forme of an
 act of assembly of this province now in force in such case made and
 provided to.

On the back of the preceding indictment was endorsed as follows viz. True
 bill of John Evans foreman

and the ap^{ts} Mary Savender being called came and in her proper person ap^{ts}
 to the ap^{ts} Indictment and saith that she cannot gainsay but that she is
 guilty of committing fornication with a negro man and submits herselfe
 to the Court on the Indictment ap^{ts}. Therefore it is considered by the Court
 here viz This Twentieth second day of November Anno Domini one thousand
 seven hundred and seventeen that the ap^{ts} Mary Savender serve this County
 seven years from the expiration of her time of service for committing the ap^{ts}
 offense of fornication with a negro man according to Act of assembly in
 such case made and provided and also pay the sume of two hundred and
 twenty pounds of Tobacco Cost accruing on the premises ap^{ts} to the officers of
 this Court.

ordered by the Court here that the ap^{ts} Mary Savender serve six months to
 her ap^{ts} Master William Glenwill for trouble disgrace of his house & loss of
 time and charge in bringing her to bed which said six months is to be had
 at the expiration of the ap^{ts} Marys now time of service.

ordered by the Court here that the ap^{ts} William Glenwill have allowed him
 in the Levy this Court three hundred pounds of Tobacco for keeping the Molatto
 Child was last delivered of the ap^{ts} Mary Savender in his service

ordered by the Court here that the said Molatto Child be sold to any person
 that will make purchase of the same until the said Child shall arrive at
 the age of thirty one years

On which William Glenwill ap^{ts} comes into Court and saith that he
 will give the ap^{ts} three hundred pounds of Tobacco the Court allowed him
 for keeping the said Molatto Child which the Court accepts of and the ap^{ts}
 Child to serve the ap^{ts} William Glenwill until the said Molatto
 shall arrive at the age of thirty one year the said Molatto being
 now about three months old

ordered
