do not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be held for
said County to answer unto all such things as should be objected ag-
ainst him on his Lordships behalfs and in the mean time to be of good
behaviour wherewith he acknowledges himself to be content

Likewise Came into Court John Cayton & John Mackey both of this County
and acknowledges themselves indebted to his Lordship his heirs & successors
in the full & just sum of ten pounds sterling each to be levied on their
goods and Chattells Lands & Tenements conditionally that if the apt
John Jones shall not make his personall appearance at the next
Court to answer as aforesaid and that in the mean time he is to be of
good behaviour wherewith they acknowledge themselves to be content
ordered by the Court here that Joseph Weldon enter into recognizance
as prosecutor ag. the apt John Jones

The apt Joseph Weldon comes into Court and acknowledges himself
indebted to his Lordship his heirs & successors in the full & just sum of
Twenty pounds sterling to be levied on his goods & Chattells Lands &
Tenements conditionally that if he do not make his personall appear-
ance at the next Court to be held for said County to prosecute on his Lordships
behalfs against the apt John Jones wherewith he acknowledges
himself content
