said Writt came Simon Wilmer Gent. high Sheriff of said County and
made return thereof in these words thereon Enrolled as follows viz

when said Writt issued forth and Copy thereof served therewith according
to Act of Assembly in such Case made was as followeth viz

the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill obligatory with the seal
of the said Walter sealed acknowledged himself to owe and stand indebted

of five hundred pounds of Tobacco qualified & Conditioned as aforesaid with Cask
as aforesaid to Contain the same as aforesaid to be paid to the same Richard
Convenient in the aforesaid County of Queen Anns on or before the tenth day of
October next ensuing the aforesaid twenty second day of February Anno Domini one
thousand seven hundred and fourteen aforesaid and for the performance thereof
the aforesaid Walter did bind himself his heirs Executors and Administrators firmly by a
certain Nevertheless the aforesaid Walter altho' often requested the aforesaid sum or
quantity of five hundred pounds of Tobacco qualified and Conditioned as
aforesaid in Cask as aforesaid convenient as aforesaid of value of five pounds Sterling money
