Thomas Taylor - Charles ab. late Lord and proprietor of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Robert Maxwell) Baltimore &c Whereas at a Court held at our Court house on Chester River in the Town of Chester in said County on the fifth day of August in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven hundred and thirteen Before Sir William Pearce and his associates then Justices of the peace for our late Lady Queen Anne for the County of Kent judicially sitting then held for Kent County as in a Cause then and there depending on Sir facias on a Judgment before that time obtained in the said County viz. on the seventh day of March in the Year of our Lord Christ one Thousand Seven hundred and Nine before Lieutenant Col Edward Blay and his associates then Justices of our said late Lady Queen Anne for the County of Kent judicially sitting then held for Kent County as in a Cause then and there depending Between Thomas Taylor of said County planter. ptt. and Robert Maxwell of Kent County as in the Province as planter's Debt. the said ptt. recovered Judgment against the said Robert Maxwell on Ballance the sum of four hundred ninety four pounds of Tobacco Certain Damages whereof he was Condit as appears upon Record and Satisfaction thereof having not been made Sir facias issued as aforesaid that is to say the said Debt came into Court the fifth day of August aforesaid and Confess Judgment to the Sir facias on the Judgment as mentioned being for the sum of four hundred ninety four pounds of Tobacco Certain Damages mentioned in the same Sir facias whereof he was Condit the said fifth day of August Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and thirteen whereof he was by his Confession of Judgment he was Condit as appears upon Record as also the sum of Three hundred and three pounds of Tobacco Cost Expended by the said ptt. in prosecuting the said writ of Sir facias and for that Execution have not thereupon yett Issued we therefore Command you that by good and Lawfull men of your County with you make known unto the said Robert Maxwell that he do and appear before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November next to show cause if any he have why Execution should not issue forth against him for the Damages and Cost in the Judgment as specified And how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto the Justices of our said Court at the day and place as hereof you are not to fail at your perill and have you then and there the names of the persons before whom you shall make the same known and this writ WITNESSE Nathaniel Hyson Gent chiefe Justice of our said Court this 22^d day of August in the second Year of our
