as follo^r: These are to certify to the Justices within mentioned that by virtue
of the within Writ to me directed I have made known unto the within
named Robert Maxwell that he be and appear at the time and place
within mentioned to shew cause why he has why Execution should
not pass both against him for the damages and Cost in the Judgment
within mentioned obtained against him by the within named
Thomas Taylor before Abraham Ambrose and John Gresham good
Execution of my said judgment &c And to witness S Wilmer Sheriff.

And here of this Court came the aforesd by his atty aforesd and prayd
that Judgment on the said Plaintiff aforesd may be entered if no cause shown
to the contrary And no person coming into this cause why Execution
should not pass on the same by which the debt might still remain
unexecuted: Therefore it is considered by the Court here by this
Eighteenth day of March Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred
and Seventeen That for the aforesd sum of four hundred Ninety four
pounds of Tobacco Damages aforesd as also the sum of Three hundred
and three pounds of Tobacco Cost aforesd mentioned which in the whole
amount unto the sum of Seven hundred Ninety Seven pounds of
Tobacco And that the said Plaintiff Thomas Taylor have thereof Execution
against the aforesd Defendant Robert Maxwell as also for the sum of three
hundred and twenty two pounds of Tobacco Cost by the aforesd expended
on the aforesd writ of fieri facias and by the Court here of his assent adjudged
