 and unjustly detain by damage of him the said p^t. Twelve pounds
 Sterling thereupon he brings Petⁿ to the Hon^l Judges & doth
 and the said Deft^l being called came and the app^l Deft^l in his proper
 person appeared to the app^l Court and doth that he cannot gainay the
 Court app^l of him the said p^t. nor but that the Bill obligatory app^l
 mentioned is his Act and deed and that he oweth unto the app^l
 the app^l Sum of one thousand pounds of Tobacco and is willing that
 Judgment should be entered for the same & Cost thereon according
 therefore it is ordered by the Court here viz: this Twentieth
 day of March Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred
 and Seventeen That the app^l Charles Smith do recover against
 the said Deft^l John Manning as well the app^l Sum of one thousand
 pounds of Tobacco Debt as also the Sum of two hundred and
 Sixty pounds of Tobacco Cost by the app^l about his Petⁿ in this
 behalf depending and by the Court here of his assent adjudged and
 the said Deft^l in mercy
