Province aforesaid if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him safe kept to  
 that he have his body before his said Lordships Justices of the next Court  
 to be held at our Court house in the Town of Quetta in said County to answer  
 unto William Frisby of a plea that he render him the full and just sum  
 of Three Thousand eight hundred sixty eight pounds of every way well qualifi-  
 ed Tobacco in well Seasoned Cask of the price and value of thirty eight  
 pounds Sterling money which from him unjustly detains &c. And that  
 he have then and there the said writ &c. All which said next Court  
 viz<sup>t</sup> the eighteenth day of March the same year last mentioned the day  
 of return of said writ came Simon Warner Gent. High Sheriff of said  
 County and made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed as fol-  
 low. Cap. Copur. S. Warner Sher. And a Dec<sup>r</sup> being filed when  
 said writ issued both and a Copy thereof served herewith according  
 to Act of Assembly in such case made was as fol<sup>d</sup> by Yent County S.  
Jonah Cohen of Kent County planter all did for County of Kent City &  
Province aforesaid was summoned to answer unto William Frisby  
 of a plea that he render him the full and just sum of Three Thousand  
 eight hundred sixty eight pounds of every way well qualified Tobacco in  
 well Seasoned Cask of the price and value of thirty eight pounds Sterling  
 money which from him unjustly detains &c. And whereupon the afo<sup>r</sup> said  
 by Thomas Rowne his atty. Genl. that whereas the afo<sup>r</sup> said the fifth  
 day of May in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven hundred  
 Seventeen at St. Pauls parish in Kent County within the jurisdiction  
 of this Court by his certain writing obligatory which he the said Deft<sup>r</sup>  
 sealed with his Seal and as his dec<sup>r</sup> delivered herunto Court brought  
 the date whereof is the same day & year afo<sup>r</sup> granted himself his Heirs  
 &c. & Rem<sup>s</sup>. holden and firmly bound unto the afo<sup>r</sup> said in the afo<sup>r</sup> full &  
 just sum of Three Thousand eight hundred sixty eight pounds of every  
 way well qualified Tobacco in well Seasoned Cask of the afo<sup>r</sup> price and value  
 of thirty eight pounds Sterling money to be paid to the afo<sup>r</sup> said in some  
 convenient place in the said County when thereunto required yet the afo<sup>r</sup>  
 Deft<sup>r</sup> altho<sup>ugh</sup> often required the afo<sup>r</sup> sum of Three Thousand eight hundred  
 Sixty & eight pounds of Tobacco to the said afo<sup>r</sup> hath not paid but that he  
 hath to render or pay <sup>hath</sup> ~~hath~~ ~~denied~~ & still doth deny & unjustly detain  
 to the damage of him the said afo<sup>r</sup> Seventy pounds Sterling money  
 and thereupon he brings Suite &c. Thomas Rowne of Kent County  
 And the said Deft<sup>r</sup> being called came and the said afo<sup>r</sup> by his afo<sup>r</sup>  
 prays that the said Deft<sup>r</sup> may give Special Bail to the afo<sup>r</sup> which  
 is granted and that he be kept in safe Custody by the Sheriff of said  
 County.
