the Debt the Condemnation aff shall not satisfy nor himselfe to the Custody  
of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the said Jonas Lantham the body  
of the said John Jones shall not render ff.

and the said Debt in his proper person appears to the action and this  
Court orders that the said Debt plead to the said Action by the twentieth day of March  
otherwise Judgment to be rendered for want of the same. But afterwards the  
said Debt comes into Court and saith that he cannot pay the Action of the  
sum the said ptt nor but that he oweth on bail to the said ptt the appraisment  
of eight hundred sixty four pounds of Tobacco and is willing that Judgment  
should be entered for the same & Est thereon during. Wherefore it is

do recover against the said Debt John Jones as well the appraisment of eight  
hundred sixty four pounds of Tobacco Damages as also the sume of five  
hundred twenty four pounds of Tobacco Est by the said ptt about his sute in  
this behalfe expended and by the Court here of his assent adjudged and the  
said Debt in mercy ff.
