 in his Duty work and him safe keep so that he have his body
 before his said Lordships Justice of the next Court to be held at our
 Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto
 William Fitz Redmond of a plea that he render him the full and
 just Quantity of one thousand pounds of Tobacco of the value
 of four pounds Sterling money which from him he unjustly
 detains &c. AND that he have them and there the said writ
 &c. AND which said next Court by the eighteenth day of
 March the same year last mentioned the day of return
 of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent High Sheriff of
 said County and made return thereof in these words thereon

 AND it being shewd when said writ issued forth &
 a Copy thereof served therewith according to Act of Assembly
 in such Case made was as follow. Next County to Dennis
 Sullivan of Kent County planter did Dennis Sulavane
 of Kent County Gentleman was summoned to answer unto
 William Fitz Redmond of a plea that he render him the
 full and just Quantity of one thousand pounds of Tobacco
 of the value of four pounds Sterling money which from
 him he unjustly detains &c. AND Whereupon the ap^{pt}
 by Thomas Bewne his atty South that whereas the ap^{pt}
 the first day of December in the year of our Lord Christ one
 thousand seven hundred and fourteen at St. Pauls parish in
 Kent within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing ob-
 -ligatory which he the said Deft sealed with his Seal and as
 his deed delivered hereunto Comt brought the date whereof is the
 same day and year ap granted himself holden and firmly Comt
 unto the ap^{pt} in the ap full and just Quantity of one thousand
 pounds of Tobacco of the ap value of four pounds Sterling money
 to be paid unto the ap^{pt} when thereunto required yet the ap^{pt}
 Deft altho often required the ap Summe of one thousand pounds
 of Tobacco to the said p^{tt} hath not paid but that he him to render
 or pay the said Deft. hitherto hath denied and still doth deny and
 unjustly detains to the damage of him the said p^{tt} twenty pounds Sterling
