Commanded show to the Justices of Kent County
the sixteenth day of Novemb. in the second
year of his most Majestie George 3. That he
take John Hodges of Kent County Manner if
he should be found in his Baylwin and him safe keep so that
he have his body before his said Majesties Justices of the next
Court to be holden at our Court house in the Town of Ruster in
said County to answer unto George Hill of a plea of Trespass
upon the Case and that he have then and there the said
writ be. At which said next Court by the twentieth day of
March the same year last mentioned the day of return of said
writ came William Frisby Gent high Sheriff of said County
and made return thereof in these words thereon indorsed
as follows by Capi Corpus qd' Frisby the said said
being filed in said Court and a copy thereof served therewith
according to Act of Assembly in such Case made which said
is entered as afd and the Deft being called came to
answer the same as afd and the app't by Tho' Bowne
his atty prayd that the Deft might give special bayle
to the same as afd which was granted after which
William Glenwill of this County in Court came and did
acknowledge himselfe special Bayle in the same action
