 Park and Michael Hackett both of this County into Court and they and others of
 them Acknowledged themselves special Bayle to the above return and joyntly &
 severally do undertake the payment of the Debt and Cost thereon accru-
 ing if it shall happen that the said Deft. shall obtain Judgment against the
 said Deft. in the said return of Debt and the Condemnation shall not satisfy
 nor himselfe to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the said
 Robert Park and Michael Hackett or either of them the body of the said
 Robert Masfield shall not render &c. AND the said Robert Max-
 field in his proper person appeared to the above return and prayed liberty
