Likewise Comanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent Coly the twenty first day of August of same year last mentioned and of Sheriff made return thereof on the Twentieth day of Novemb^r of same year last mentioned - Non est Inventus

and a Declaration being filed when the first writ issued forth and a Copy thereof sent therewith which sold by the said Coly's Walter King of Kent County Tannor and did Walter King of Kent County Tannor was summoned to answer Thomas Bowne of a plea that he render him of sum of sixteen hundred thirty & six pounds of good sound Merchantable leafe Tobacco in Cash of the value of thirteen pounds twelve Shillings and eight pence Sterling money which he unjustly detaineth. and whereupon the afo Thomas in proper person saith that whereas the afo Walter the Eighteenth day of April Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and fifteen at Pauls Parish in Kent County afo within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his written obligatory which the said Walter sealed with his Seal and at his deed delivered here into Court brought the date whereof is the same day of year afo granted himself holden and firmly bounden to the afo Thomas in the afo sum of sixteen hundred thirty & six pounds of good sound Merchantable leafe Tobacco in Cash of the value of thirteen pounds twelve Shillings & eight pence Sterling money to be paid to the afo Thomas when hundred thirty & six pounds of Tobacco to the said Thomas hath not rendered or paid but the same to render or pay the said Walter hitherto hath denied and yett doth deny and unjustly detain to the damage of the said Thomas Twenty pounds Sterling money and thereupon he brings Suite &c &c Bowne in person p^r &c.
