and the Grand Jury having found a Bill against the afo James which
 stood by Kent County Maryland to The Jurors for our Lord Proprietor & the
 body of Kent County afo upon their Oath do present that James Gee late
 of Kent County afo Labourer the twenty second day of October in the year
 of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Sixteen by force and arms
 & with Morgans each upper hundred in the County afo the Mansion house
 of a certain William Edwards about the Second hour in the night of
 the same day entered the said William and Susanna his wife with
 others in the said house then and there being in the peace of God &
 the Lord Proprietor & the said William Edwards and Susanna his wife
 in such a manner did assault and the said William and Susanna then
 and there did beat wound and will entreat so that of their lives it was
 greatly dispaireed off against the peace of our Lord Proprietor his Rule
 & dignity he & Johnson & no prop on the back of the afo Bill
 was endorsed vñ Bellabera & me Simon Wilmer Foreman
 Wm. Williams Presilla Wilmer Lachnor Middleton
 The afo James in his prop person afo to the afo Indult. and saith
 that he cannot gainsay the same and saith that as to what is
 said in the afo Indult he submits to the Court. Therefore
 it is Considered by the Court here by this twenty third day
 of November anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and
 Sixteen that the afo James Gee be paid the summe of one hundred
 pounds of Tobacco on condit of assaulting the afo William Edwards
 & Susanna his wife as also pay the summe of Three hundred
 and twenty eight pounds of Tobacco Cost on the promises afo to
 the officers of this Court.

William Edwards & Susanna his wife be bound by recognizance
 as prosecutors ag^t the afo James Gee by the afo Justice in the summe
 of five pounds sterl. they both app^t to the same this Court
 here discharge the same recognizance
