fore man all so say The p<sup>t</sup> by his a<sup>d</sup> Battay prayd Judgment  
on the Verdict aff<sup>d</sup> Therefore it is Considered by the  
Court here in this twenty fourth day of November anno Domini  
one thousand Seven hundred and sixteen that the afo<sup>d</sup> p<sup>t</sup>  
John Fanning recover against the said D<sup>t</sup> John Moore as  
well the afo<sup>d</sup> sume of Seven hundred Eighty two pounds of  
Tobacco and one half pound of Tob. and one hundred and  
Eighty pounds of Tobacco in the whole amounting to the sume  
of Eight hundred and ninety pounds of Tobacco and one half  
pound of Tob. Damages by the Jury aff<sup>d</sup> assessed as also the  
sume of Six hundred forty four pounds of Tobacco £ 1 by the  
p<sup>t</sup> aff<sup>d</sup> suspended and by the Court here of his a<sup>d</sup> spent adjudged and  
the said D<sup>t</sup> in mercy etc.
