(House Bill 1684)

AN ACT concerning

State Government - Contract Immunity

## Preamble

WHEREAS, Chapter 450 of the Acts of 1976, (the "Sovereign Immunity Act") which was codified in Article 41, \$-109A \$ 10A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, prohibited this State and every officer, department, agency, board, commission, or other unit of State government, unless otherwise specifically provided by the laws of Maryland, from raising the defense of sovereign immunity in the courts of this State in an action in contract based upon any written contract executed on behalf of this State, or any of its departments, agencies, boards, commissions, or units by an official or employee acting within the scope of his authority; and
