- (2) the completion of the contract that gives rise to the claim.

To carry out this subtitle, the Governor shall include in the budget bill money that is adequate to satisfy a final judgment that, after the exhaustion of the rights of appeal, is rendered against the State or any of its officers or units.

## CHAPTER 266

(House Bill 1701)

AN ACT concerning

Jurisdiction - Juvenile Court and Equity Court

FOR the purpose of providing that if an equity court orders an adoption, guardianship with the right to consent to adoption, or long-term care short of adoption for a child adjudicated to be in need of assistance, a neglected child, an abused child, or a dependent child, the jurisdiction of the juvenile court terminates; and generally relating to the court jurisdiction of certain children in need of assistance.
