(d) (l) In Baltimore City, the Sheriff shall receive a He shall appoint an undersheriff and chief salary of \$37,500. deputy sheriff, three supervisory deputy sheriffs, one deputy sheriff writ clerk and four assistant deputy sheriff writ clerks, stenographer and docket clerk, two clerks and he may appoint deputy sheriffs. In addition to any other a total of 61 compensation received, each sheriff shall receive an expense allowance of [\$100] \$400 \$200 annually for: (i) ammunition practice sessions at the range; (ii) clothing allowance to defray the cost of dry cleaning and maintaining the clothing worn while on duty; and (iii) the purchase and maintenance of other to fulfill necessary their duties that currently are not furnished by the Baltimore City Sheriff's department. for these employees shall be set by the Secretary of Personnel. A deputy sheriff who uses his personal automobile is entitled to monthly automobile allowance at the same rate paid to other employees. Any Sheriff who is assigned a city-owned automobile may not receive the monthly automobile expense They shall also have assistants at the compensation allowance. provided for in the annual ordinance of estimates of Baltimore City. Provision shall also be made in the ordinance for the expenses of the office of the Sheriff, including the purchase and maintenance of motor vehicles. The Mayor and City Council have the same power with respect to the salaries of the office of the Sheriff as they have under the city charter with respect to Employees all municipal departments. Sheriff's office, except the Sheriff, shall be selected according to the provisions of § 9E of Article 64A of the Code.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
