SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Tax - Property

9-302.

- (b) The governing body of Allegany County or of a municipal corporation in Allegany County may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on:
  - (1) property that is:
- (i) owned by the National Board of Young Men's Christian Associations; and
- (ii) known as the Railroad YMCA of Cumberland; [and]
- (2) property that is owned by the Upper Potomac Jaycees, Incorporated; AND
- (3) PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY THE ALLEGANY BEAGLE CLUB, INCORPORATED.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

## CHAPTER 280

(House Bill 1863)

AN ACT concerning

Enterprise Zones - Income Tax Credits for Rehiring Laid Off Workers

FOR the purpose of authorizing income tax credits to a business entity that locates in an enterprise zone and rehires workers who have been laid off for a certain period of time; reducing the period of time that a rehired employee must have been laid off to be a "qualified employee" under enterprise zone law; providing for the certification and approval of the tax credit; providing for the retroactive application of this Act; providing for the termination date of this Act; and generally relating to income tax credits allowed business entities located in enterprise zones for the rehiring of laid off workers.
