(o) (2) The primary duties of the Sheriff are the following:

(iii) Additional duties, including law enforcement as may be requested by [a] law enforcement or other criminal justice agencies, the courts, or the county government, when necessary for the public safety.

DRAFTER'S NOTE: This corrects a grammatical error in § 2-309(o)(2)(iii) of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article.

The grammatical error occurred in Ch. 426 of the Acts of the Regular Session of the General Assembly of 1985.

The grammatical error was noted by the State Attorney General in his bill review letter of April 23, 1985.

4-302.

(a) Except as provided in [§ 4-301(b)(2)] §§ 4-301(B)(2) AND 4-301(B)(6) of this subtitle, the District Court does not have jurisdiction to try a criminal case charging the commission of a felony.

DRAFTER'S NOTE: This corrects the omission of a cross-reference to a provision of law in § 4-302(a) of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article.

Ch. 468 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1980 gave the District Court jurisdiction over a violation of Article 27, § 141 "whether a felony or a misdemeanor".

The omission of the cross-reference was noted by the Administrative Office of the Courts of Maryland.

Among other things, the juror selection plan referred to in § 8-201 shall:
