(2) The reason for the withdrawal.

- [B] Before July 1. 1986. the Governor shall notify any official required to file a supplemental statement under the reporting requirement of subsection [A] of this section and the date that knowledge of the financially impaired condition was first acquired.
- (C) Every State official or public official shall be required to file with the State Ethics Commission a supplemental statement pursuant to Article 40A, § 4-102 of the Code disclosing the amounts of any withdrawals of certificates of deposit where the official incurred any penalty or forfeited any interest as a result of the withdrawal, from any savings and loan association formerly insured by the Maryland Savings-Share Insurance Corporation, by the official, or any interest attributable to such official pursuant to Article 40A, § 4-104 of the Annotated Code, during the period from March 14, 1985 through May 14, 1985.
- [A] and (C) of this section shall be filed by August 1, 1986.

SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That:

- (A) The State Prosecutor shall compile a list of persons who:
