(B) "AUTHORITY" MEANS THE MARYLAND SPORTS STADIUM AUTHORITY.

~~(1) STADIUMS, ARENAS, OR OTHER STRUCTURES FOR THE HOLDING OF ATHLETIC CONTESTS OR EVENTS, INCLUDING BASEBALL, FOOTBALL, AND AUTOMOBILE RACING; AND~~

~~(2) PRACTICE FIELDS, OR OTHER AREAS WHERE PROFESSIONAL SPORTS TEAMS MAY PRACTICE OR PERFORM.~~

~~(D) "FACILITY" ALSO MEANS THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF PROPERTY IF THAT PROPERTY IS DIRECTLY RELATED TO AN ITEM LISTED IN SUBSECTION (c) OF THIS SECTION:~~

(C) "FACILITY" MEANS:

(1) STADIUMS FOR THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF HOLDING PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL GAMES, MAJOR LEAGUE PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL GAMES, FOOTBALL GAMES, OR BOTH IN THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN AREA, AS DEFINED UNDER REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL LAW; AND

(2) PRACTICE FIELDS, OR OTHER AREAS WHERE PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL OR MAJOR LEAGUE PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL AND FOOTBALL TEAMS MAY PRACTICE OR PERFORM; AND
