

(C) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT PRECLUDE THE AUTHORITY FROM CONSIDERING THE FULL RANGE OF ALTERNATIVES IN SELECTING A SITE FOR A MAJOR SPORTS FACILITY IN THE BALTIMORE AREA, INCLUDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW FACILITY AND THE REHABILITATION OF THE MEMORIAL STADIUM FACILITY.

(e) (D) IN THE ANNUAL REPORT REQUIRED UNDER § 13-719 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE AUTHORITY SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION ON:

(1) ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS THAT OCCURRED AT MEMORIAL STADIUM DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR;

(2) EFFORTS TO SOLICIT EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES FOR MEMORIAL STADIUM; AND

(3) PLANS AND GOALS FOR EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES AT MEMORIAL STADIUM DURING THE COMING YEAR.
