For any project listed in Section 1(3) of this Act for which funds for construction are appropriated and for which the preliminary plans and outline specifications required by § 5-309(f)(2)(i) of the State Finance and Procurement Article have not been prepared, the State agency or institution responsible for the project shall submit the plans and outline specifications to the Department of State Planning for approval before the construction funds may be spent.
