AN ACT concerning

Ambient Air Quality - Permits and Registrations - Hearings

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, before issuing a-permit-or-registration-that-allows certain permits that allow a person to do certain acts that may cause emissions in the air, to give notice of the application,—to—hold Department's intended action, to give an opportunity for a public hearing, and to issue or deny the permit or-registration within a certain time period; providing for the application of this Act: providing—a certain—exception; and generally relating to hearings—for the issuance of a permit or-registration concerning ambient air quality control.
