5-604.

(a) Subject to the provisions of [paragraphs] SUBSECTIONS (b) and (c) of this section and if the declarant is unable to give directions regarding the use of life-sustaining procedures, the attending physician of a declarant in a terminal condition shall promptly:

(1) Take the actions necessary to provide for the certification required for the declarant to become a qualified patient; and

(2) Upon certification, implement the declaration.
