{E} (D) FEES; EXPENSES. (1) THE SECRETARY MAY SET A SLIDING FEE SCHEDULE FOR SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION.

{G} (E) ANNUAL REPORT. (1) ON OR BEFORE - JANUARY JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

(2) THE ANNUAL REPORT SHALL CONTAIN:

(I) THE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT ON THE EFFECTIVENESS, IMPACT, AND BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAMS UNDER THIS SECTION;

(II) AN EVALUATION OF EACH PROGRAM; AND

(III) ANY PROPOSED LEGISLATION THAT THE DEPARTMENT CONSIDERS NECESSARY AND PROPER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 300

(Senate Bill 157)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Recovery of Benefit Overpayments

FOR the purpose of authorizing clarifying the authority of the Board of Trustees for Maryland State Retirement and Pension Systems to recover certain benefit payments and overpayments; authorizing the Board of Trustees to recover
