AN ACT concerning

Nursing Care - Institutions for Elderly Individuals -
Bonding of Employees

FOR the purpose of requiring certain related institutions that care for elderly individuals to provide a-bond certain financial assurances of a certain amount for specified employees; and providing a certain delayed effective date.
