

presented by June 1, 1988, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

(6) The Glenbrook Day School shall demonstrate to the Board of Public Works that the Glenbrook Day School has adopted a policy to accept all students on a first come, first served basis to assure residents of all subdivisions of the State equal access to the use of the facility.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1986.

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CHAPTER 315

(Senate Bill 325)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Community Mental Health  
Facilities, Addiction Facilities,  
Mental Retardation Facilities,  
and Developmental Disabilities  
Facilities Loan of 1986

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$1,500,000, the proceeds to be used for State grants to certain public and other nonprofit entities for the construction, acquisition, renovation, and equipping of community mental health facilities, addiction facilities, mental retardation facilities, and developmental disabilities facilities, including reports, plans, specifications, site improvements, surveys, and programs in connection therewith; defining certain terms; requiring certain information from grantees; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to adopt regulations, including regulations providing for continuing information; placing limits on the amount of the grants; providing that under certain circumstances the State may recover a certain portion of the State funds expended; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Community Mental Health Facilities,
