(a) In addition to the State prosecuting a criminal action under any provision of this subtitle, the Attorney General may bring a civil action in the circuit court of the county or city [were] WHERE the mining operation is located against any person who violates any provision of this subtitle or any regulation, permit, notice, or order issued under this subtitle. The circuit court may find the violator liable to the State for a penalty not exceeding \$5,000 for each offense. Each day on which the violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.

(a) Pursuant to § 10-205[,] of this title, the Department shall establish by rule or regulation and publish by July 1 each year the open season, excepting Sundays, to hunt the forest and upland game birds and mammals.
