section of this Division II of this article or of any other law of this State, procurement of the supplies shall be made in accordance with the other provisions of law.

(2) If suitable supplies or services are not available for procurement from any department or agency of the State under the provisions of paragraph (1) of this subsection, the pricing and selection committee shall determine whether the supplies or services are available for procurement from an eligible sheltered workshop.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

(Senate Bill 483)
