(Senate Bill 594)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Historic Motor Vehicle - Definition

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "historic motor vehicle" to include certain vehicles that are commonly referred to as "street rods" and that meet certain requirements; altering a definition of the term "historic motor vehicle" to exclude certain remanufactured or reconstructed vehicle replicas; and generally relating to the definition of "historic motor vehicle" for the purpose of a certain special vehicle registration.
