- [(f)] (G) Unless the presence of the equipment was specifically required by a statute of this State as a condition of sale when the vehicle was manufactured, the presence of any specific equipment is not required for the operation of a vehicle registered under this section.
- [(g)] (H) A vehicle registered under this section is exempt from any statute that requires periodic vehicle inspections or that requires the use and inspection of emission controls.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 349

(Senate Bill 596)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Loyola College

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation a State Debt in the amount of \$274007000 \$2,000,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to Loyola College to assist in the planning, design, alteration, addition, and equipping of Donnelly Science Center, subject to the requirement that Loyola College provide up to a certain sum of a certain type of funds as a matching fund for the same purpose by a certain date; providing that no proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be used for religious purposes; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:
- (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Loyola College Loan of 1986 in the total principal amount of \$2,469,000 \$2,000,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with \$\$ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, \$ 22 of the Code.
- (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a single issue, or may be consolidated and
