- (i) 6 members shall be REAL ESTATE licensees, at least one of whom is also a homebuilder;
- (ii) 1 shall be a member of the low income housing advisory board;
- (iii) 2 shall be representatives of nonprofit housing organizations; and
 - (iv) 2 shall be public members.
- (3) The Governor shall appoint the board members with the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (4) Board members shall be residents of the State who represent the different regions of the State.
- (5) The Secretary of the Department of Economic and Community Development or the Secretary's designee shall sit as an ex officio, nonvoting member of the board.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
