(A) (E) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "WEEKEND PRISONER" MEANS A PRISONER UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE SHERIFF OF HARFORD COUNTY, WHOSE SENTENCE IS TO BE PERFORMED DURING ANY 48-HOUR PERIOD IN ANY 7-DAY PERIOD, WITH EACH PERIOD OF CONFINEMENT TO CONSTITUTE NOT LESS THAN 2 DAYS OF THE SENTENCE IMPOSED.

(B) (2) HARFORD COUNTY MAY COLLECT FROM A "WEEKEND PRISONER" AN AMOUNT DETERMINED TO BE THE COST TO THE COUNTY OF PROVIDING FOOD, LODGING, AND CLOTHING FOR THE PRISONER. THE COURT MAY WAIVE ANY OR ALL OF THIS CHARGE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
