(d) Any disabled veteran whose vehicle is eligible for exemption under subsection [(a)(9)] (A)(8) of this section and who also is eligible for a special, disabled persons registration number under § 13-616 of this title may elect to receive the special registration number and special registration plates provided for in that section, without payment of the registration fees specified in this subtitle.

(d) (1) Subject to the regulations adopted under this subtitle, any resident of this State who possesses a valid Class E driver's license, a Class E learner's permit, or is eligible for a Class E learner's [permit] PERMIT, may enroll in a course.
