CHAPTER 390

(Senate Bill 945)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages

FOR the purpose of altering the amount of capital investment necessary as a requirement for restaurants to qualify for a certain alcoholic beverages license in Baltimore City; including Baltimore City in a certain provision of law that allows a person of a certain age or older to be employed to sell, serve, deliver, or otherwise deal with alcoholic beverages; increasing-the-fine-that-the-Baltimore-City-board-of--license--commissioners--may--charge---a---licensee---for violations--of--alcoholic-beverages-laws-affecting-Baltimore City; and providing for the applicability of the Act.
