

(A) (1) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL CONSISTS OF 19 MEMBERS.

(2) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS FROM A LIST OF QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY THE SECRETARY.

(3) OF THE 19 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS SHALL REPRESENT EACH OF THE FOLLOWING GROUPS:

(I) 1 SHALL REPRESENT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE;

(II) 1 SHALL REPRESENT THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT;

(III) 1 SHALL REPRESENT THE PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE INDUSTRY;

(IV) 1 SHALL REPRESENT THE MORTGAGE BANKING INDUSTRY;

(V) 1 SHALL REPRESENT THE MARYLAND OCCUPATIONAL, SAFETY, AND HEALTH OFFICE (MOSH);

(VI) 3 SHALL REPRESENT OWNERS OF RENTAL PROPERTY IN AREAS WITH A SIGNIFICANT PRESENCE OF LEAD-BASED PAINT;

(VII) 3 SHALL REPRESENT TENANTS OF RENTAL PROPERTY IN AREAS WITH A SIGNIFICANT PRESENCE OF LEAD-BASED PAINT, 1 OF WHOM SHALL BE A PARENT OF A CHILD WHO HAS EXPERIENCED LEAD POISONING;

(VIII) 2 SHALL REPRESENT LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IN AREAS WITH A SIGNIFICANT PRESENCE OF LEAD-BASED PAINT, 1 OF WHOM SHALL BE FROM BALTIMORE CITY;

(IX) 2 SHALL BE HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS WHO ARE KNOWLEDGEABLE IN THE FIELD OF LEAD POISONING PREVENTION, MANAGEMENT, AND TREATMENT;

(X) 2 SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;
AND

(XI) 2 EX OFFICIO MEMBERS AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C)(4) OF THIS SECTION.

(B) EACH MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS KNOWLEDGEABLE ABOUT OR HAS A SERIOUS INTEREST IN THE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT OF LEAD POISONING.

(C) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.

(2) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
