

PERSON-HAS-BEEN-NOTIFIED-OF-THE-SUBPOENA-BY-THE-PARTY-SEEKING-THE INFORMATION--and--OF--any--requirements-made-of-the-issuer-by-the subpoena--A-notice-of--such--subpoena--sent--to--the--last--known address-of-the-credit-card-holder-shall-be-deemed-compliance-with this--section COMPLIES WITH § 1-304 OF THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS ARTICLE.

Article - Financial Institutions

1-304.

(a) In this section, "subpoena" means a subpoena, summons, warrant, or court order that appears on its face to have been issued on lawful authority.

(b) A fiduciary institution may disclose OR PRODUCE FINANCIAL RECORDS OR INFORMATION DERIVED FROM financial records in compliance with a subpoena SERVED ON THE FIDUCIARY INSTITUTION, if:

(1) [the] THE subpoena [is served on the fiduciary institution and, unless waived by the court for good cause, on the customer] CONTAINS A CERTIFICATION THAT A COPY OF THE SUBPOENA HAS BEEN SENT--BY--CERTIFIED--MAIL,--RETURN--RECEIPT REQUESTED, TO SERVED ON THE PERSON WHOSE RECORDS ARE SOUGHT BY THE PARTY SEEKING THE DISCLOSURE OR PRODUCTION OF THE RECORDS; OR

(2) MAILING---BY---CERTIFIED---MAIL,--RETURN--RECEIPT REQUESTED, CONTAINS A CERTIFICATION THAT SERVICE HAS BEEN WAIVED BY THE COURT FOR GOOD CAUSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 413

(House Bill 97)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Beer and Wine Tasting License

FOR the purpose of creating a Class BWT beer and wine (on premise) tasting license in Anne Arundel County by expanding the current local wine tasting license to include beer tasting; establishing fees; establishing qualifications for applicants; providing for the issuance of the license; regulating the amount of beer and wine that may be served under this license; generally relating to the creation of a
