except to the extent that the county may be the lessee of the real property and improvements thereon with respect to which the bonds are issued.

- R. (1) THE COUNTY MAY ENTER INTO A LEASE OR OTHER AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMISSION IN ORDER TO ACCOMPLISH THE PUBLIC PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.
- AND THE COMMISSION SHALL BE ON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY DETERMINE AND SHALL BE LEGALLY BINDING UPON THE COUNTY AND ENFORCEABLE AGAINST THE COUNTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS TERMS.
- ANY LEASE BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE COMMISSION MAY BE FOR A TERM OF ANY NUMBER OF YEARS, AND ANY RENT THEREUNDER PAYABLE FROM THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE COUNTY OR FROM ANY MAY SPECIAL FUNDS AS MAY DESIGNATED BE BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby-declared-to-be-an-emergency-measure-and-necessary-for-the immediate-preservation-of-the-public-health-and-safety-and-having been-passed-by-a-yea-and-nay-vote-supported-by-three-fifths-of all-the-members-elected-to-each-of-the-two-Houses-of-the-General Assembly; the-same-shall-take-effect-from-the-date-of-its-passage shall take effect June 1, 1986.
