

(I) the disabled individual, THE DISABLED INDIVIDUAL'S GUARDIAN, OR THE DISABLED INDIVIDUAL'S ATTORNEY files a petition for [early] review; OR

(II) THE REVIEW BOARD, ON ITS OWN MOTION, SCHEDULES A REVIEW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 427

(House Bill 211)

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources - Recreational Use of State-Waters
the Potomac River

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Natural Resources to adopt regulations to foster water safety for recreational uses of ~~the-State-waters~~ a certain section of the Potomac River, including swimming, bathing, wading, diving, tubing, rafting, and other uses involving contact with the water; making the Secretary responsible for administering a program of water safety for recreational uses of ~~waters-of-the-State~~ a certain section of the Potomac River; and providing a penalty for violations of Departmental regulations; and providing that nothing in this subtitle is intended to affect or limit certain powers and duties of the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene.

BY adding to

Article - Natural Resources

Section 1-601, 1-602, 1-603, and 1-604, and 1-605 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 6. Recreational Use of State-Waters the Potomac River"
