CHAPTER 432

(House Bill 246)

AN ACT concerning

Spring-Grove-Hospital-Center---Advisory-Board State Hospital Centers - Advisory Boards

FOR the purpose of increasing the membership of the Spring Grove Hospital Center Citizen's Advisory Board; requiring that the members of the Citizen's Advisory Board be residents of certain counties; specifying the terms of members of the Citizen's Advisory Board; providing for the application of this Act; requiring that one member of the Crownsville Hospital Center Board shall be a resident of a certain county; and generally relating to citizen advisory boards for State mental hygiene facilities.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health - General Section 10-411 Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Volume and 1985 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

10-411.

- (a) (1) (i) Except for the Eastern Shore Hospital Center, the Crownsville Hospital Center, [and] the Regional Institute for Children and Adolescents in Prince George's County, AND THE SPRING GROVE HOSPITAL CENTER, each Board consists of 7 members appointed by the Governor.
- (ii) The Board for the Crownsville Hospital Center consists of 9 members appointed by the Governor.
- (iii) The Board for the Eastern Shore Hospital Center consists of 11 members appointed by the Governor.
- (iv) The Board for the Regional Institute for Children and Adolescents in Prince George's County consists of 11 members appointed by the Governor.
- (V) THE BOARD FOR THE SPRING GROVE HOSPITAL CENTER CONSISTS OF 9 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.
