as is possible without requiring the early termination of the term of any member serving on the Board on the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 433

(House Bill 302)

AN ACT concerning

Pesticide Applicator's Law - Employee Testing Training
