

(2) Any vehicle that a Class D driver's license authorizes its holder to drive.

(d) A Class D driver's license authorizes the licensee to drive any vehicle or combinations of vehicles, except:

(1) Combinations of Class F (tractor) and Class G (trailer) vehicles;

(2) Vehicles or combinations of vehicles with a registered gross vehicle weight or registered gross combination weight of more than 25,000 pounds, but not including an uncoupled truck tractor;

(3) Buses ~~DESIGNED--TO-CARRY-MORE-THAN-15-PASSENGERS~~  
OVER 10,000 POUNDS GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT; and

(4) Motorcycles.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 448

(House Bill 433)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicles - Distributor - Definition
