Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 12

(House Bill 1374)

AN ACT concerning

State of Maryland Deposit Insurance Fund Corporation Powers and Remedies

FOR the purpose of clarifying certain powers and remedies available to the State of Maryland Deposit Insurance Fund expressly authorizing certain actions Corporation: procedures relating to the payment of deposit insurance, including advance payments to depositors and the execution of certain contracts with certain insured institutions; providing for the final determination of insurable loss; providing that certain moneys of the State and recoveries shall be kept in a separate account and are not subject to attachment; clarifying the doctrine of legal subrogation as it applies to the Fund; vesting the rights and claims of the former Maryland Savings-Share Insurance Corporation in the Fund; expressly providing that the Fund does not indemnify officers, directors, employees or agents of the former Maryland Savings-Share Insurance Corporation; providing the judgment lien priority subject to certain with Fund perfected vested rights; providing that certain rights, claims, and liabilities of the Fund accrue to a successor agency or the Department of Licensing and Regulation under certain circumstances; confirming the retention of the defense of sovereign immunity by the Fund except for certain written obligations; providing-for-a-partial-waiver-of-the defense--of--sovereign--immunity---under---certain---limited circumstances--and--subject--to--the-availability-of-certain funds; granting qualified immunity to agents of the Fund certain providing circumstances and certain exceptions; providing for the construction and applicability of this Act; generally relating to the State of Maryland Deposit Insurance Fund Corporation; and making this Act an emergency measure.
