- [(b)] (F) A person may not display on or for a vehicle any registration card [, registration plate, or permit] that is neither:
 - (1) Issued for the vehicle; or
- (2) Otherwise lawfully used on or for the vehicle under this title.
- (G) A PERSON MAY NOT DISPLAY ON OR FOR A VEHICLE ANY REGISTRATION PLATE THAT IS NEITHER:
 - (1) ISSUED FOR THE VEHICLE; OR
- (2) OTHERWISE LAWFULLY USED ON OR FOR THE VEHICLE UNDER THIS TITLE.
- (H) A PERSON MAY NOT DISPLAY ON OR FOR A VEHICLE ANY PERMIT THAT IS NEITHER:
 - (1) ISSUED FOR THE VEHICLE; OR
- (2) OTHERWISE LAWFULLY USED ON OR FOR THE VEHICLE UNDER THIS TITLE.

13-704.

- (A) In any application for a certificate of title [or for the registration of a vehicle], a person may not:
 - (1) Fraudulently use a false or fictitious name;
 - (2) Knowingly make a false statement;
 - (3) Knowingly conceal a material fact; or
- (4) Otherwise commit a fraud in making the application.
- (B) IN ANY APPLICATION FOR THE REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE, A PERSON MAY NOT:
 - (1) FRAUDULENTLY USE A FALSE OR FICTITIOUS NAME;
 - (2) KNOWINGLY MAKE A FALSE STATEMENT;
 - (3) KNOWINGLY CONCEAL A MATERIAL FACT; OR
- (4) OTHERWISE COMMIT A FRAUD IN MAKING THE APPLICATION.

13-708.

(A) If the Administration cancels, suspends, or revokes the certificate of title or the registration of a vehicle, the owner
